




Rainforest - Home learning grid



The children are expected to complete two of the tasks below this half term. The children can pick which tasks they would like to complete, allowing them more ownership of their work and more time to complete the tasks to a good standard.

It should be noted that the children are still expected to read every day and practise their times tables regularly (focus on 2, 5, 10, 3, 4, 6, 8).

Verbal I enjoy reading, writing and speaking.	Mathematical I enjoy working with mathematics and science.	Visual I enjoy painting, drawing and visualising.	Kinaesthetic I enjoy doing hands-on activities.	Musical I enjoy making and listening to music.
Find and learn a poem about the rainforest to perform to the class.	Design and make a game to help children learn their 3 and 4 times tables.	Draw, paint or create a collage of the rainforest.	Use natural materials to create a picture of a rainforest animal.	Compose or learn a piece of music that reminds you of the rainforest to perform to the class.
Use the internet / library to research a particular rainforest. Find out where it is, what animals live there, what the weather is like etc. Show what you have found out on a poster.	Create a poster or PowerPoint to help explain the different parts of flowering plants and their functions.	Find a leaf and sketch it in detail using a pencil.	Make a 3D diorama (model) of a rainforest.	Make an instrument that can create a rainforest sound, for example, a rain stick.
