Moving Me - Home Learning Grid Summer 2018



The children are expected to complete two of the tasks below this half term. The children can pick which tasks they would like to complete, allowing them more ownership of their work and more time to complete the tasks to a good standard.



It should be noted that the children are still expected to read every day and practise their times tables regularly (focus on 2, 5, 10, 3, 4, 6, 8).

Verbal I enjoy reading, writing and speaking.	Mathematical I enjoy working with mathematics and science.	Visual I enjoy painting, drawing and visualising.	Kinaesthetic I enjoy doing hands-on activities.	Musical I enjoy making and listening to music.
Research about different kinds of skeletons - present your information as a poster or using PowerPoint.	Find out how much you have grown since you were born - is your head bigger or smaller? How much taller are you?	Sketch or paint a picture that shows or represents an animal moving.	Create your own model of an animal or human skeleton.	Choose an animal and compose a piece of music that represents how it moves.
Create a labelled diagram of the human skeleton.	Use the internet to search find out the average weight of 3 or more animals and present the data as a bar graph.	Design a poster explaining how to stay fit and healthy.	Time yourself running a set distance. Practice running the same distance for two weeks. How much quicker were you at the end?	Find a piece of music to represent an animal and then create a dance using movements you think that animal would use.
