#### **English**

The children will continue to build confidence in writing independently. Focusing on understanding what a sentence is and how a capital letter and full stop are used. We are looking at traditional tales starting with Nursery Rhymes. There will be continued learning of securing their phonics knowledge with a particular focus on split diagraphs.

#### **Understanding of the World**

For the first half of them we shall be learning about Exeter both in the present and the past. This will include a visit by train so if you could spare some time some extra help would be welcomed. We shall then have some time learning about different materials and how plants grow.

#### Maths

Children will be securing their understanding of numbers to 100. Thinking about multiplication and division in a practical way looking at repeated additions. Lots more on shape measure and time too, with more adding and subtracting.

#### **Expressive Art and Design**

Children will be making pop up books and learning how different mechanisms can be made to help things pop up. They will be making healthy food hopefully from some of the food we have grown ourselves. They will learn how to paint still life flowers and plants and also landscape paintings.
