

Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to the summer term in Rainbow class! I hope you all enjoyed the Easter holidays.

There are a few changes this term:

- From Monday 23rd April, where possible, the children are expected to come into the conservatory and classroom on their own. This is to build their independence and prepare them ready to transition into Year 1 in September.
- Reading books will no longer be available on a free choosing basis. They will be given a reading book according to the colour band that they are working at to read at home like in Year 1. These will be changed twice a week as a minimum when the children have read the book twice and it has been noted by you in their reading record.
- PE will still be on a Thursday however the children will need to have plimsolls or trainers to wear so we can be outside!
- There will be no more Show & Tell on a Friday.

As it is the summer term we are hoping for lots of sunshine and opportunities to be outside enjoying it!. Can I ask you to make sure the children have had sun cream applied in the morning and to provide some extra in their bags for the children to apply during the day when required. Obviously water bottles will be needed (just water please!) and some may even want to bring hats to wear.

We will be doing Forest School later on in the term. It will be on a Monday for three sessions, the 2nd July, 9th July and the 16th July. The children will need to bring with them clothes that they can potentially get very mucky in!
