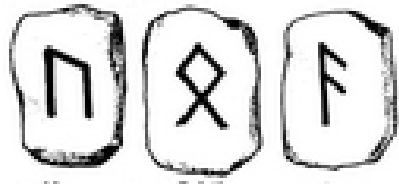


Red class creative learning ideas

Must be good at...

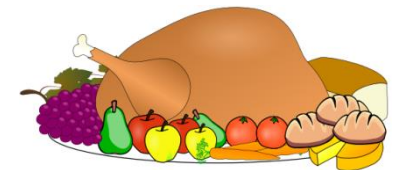
Research what the Vikings used for money.

Think about why they stayed in England.

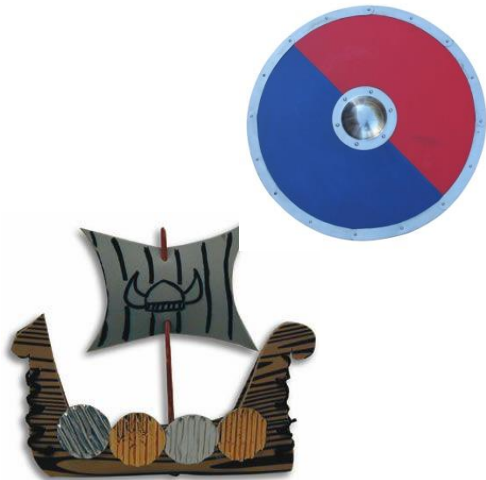
Draw and label an Anglo-Saxon man/woman showing what clothes they wore.



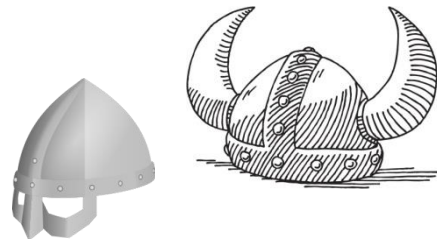
Design a dragon's head for a Viking ship's prow. Use the internet and your imagination!
