

Full Time Year 2 Teacher at Coplestone Primary School

Coplestone Primary School is set in the village of Coplestone which is located on the A377 close to Crediton and Exeter. The School is part of a successful and established federation, The Devon Moors Federation, with Spreyton Primary School, Chittlehampton C of E Primary School and Filleigh Primary School, which started in May 2014.
