

English –The children will be embedding all their previous learning. They will start by exploring different traditional tales and focus on the Egyptian Cinderella story. Creating their own fairy tale set in Egypt. The children will write non fiction information on Egyptians and recount the process of mummification. In our head north topic we shall explore local folklore and tales of the Lochness monster!

History –The Children will be discovering the fascinating world of Ancient Egyptians. Looking at what made this civilisation so successful. We shall be also looking at the process of mummification and their belief of the afterlife.

French- Children will be learning about Sports and Weather.

Maths

The children will be building on all their previous learning as they explore measure and shape. Learning about time and position with another visit to adding, subtracting, multiplication and division will help children be ready for the challenge of Year 5.

Year 4 Summer

Art and Design and Technology

We shall be exploring the art of Ancient Egyptians. Looking at how they drew people and hopefully making our own Canopic jars out of clay.

In our heading north project we shall be exploring printing and textiles through inspiration of natural wildlife of these regions. Looking at the work of William Morris and what inspired his designs.

PE Days

The children will have PE Monday and Wednesday afternoons and forest school Friday afternoon.

Science-

We shall be looking closely and the human digestive system and teeth and will link this to our learning about the Egyptians. Then we shall learn more about animals in our Heading North topic.

Geography –We shall be exploring three different places in our Heading North topic. We shall look at Scotland, Finland and Alaska. Discovering difference and similarities between these places. This will be linked to our Science topic on living things helping children to understand food chains and different types of animals.
