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First item on the agenda; Bunny Bounce

The school council voted to still have the bunny bounce. There is a new lady that has taken over Inflatafun. They do a two row bungee run that CG liked the look of but we wondered whether the younger children would be strong enough to use it. CG said she could contact them to see if we could have a bouncy castle for free and then list them on the benefactor wall.

Lots of people at the meeting felt that we had done the bunny bounce too many times, CB said that its quite hard to calm the children down afterwards when they go back into class.

We discussed what we could do instead, bouncy hoppers were suggested and also skipping. We decided to do a bunny hop which would be group skipping with a long rope with two adults turning the rope. KS found 5 metre long ropes on Amazon for £6.95 or we could ask Achieve For All if they have ropes we could borrow.

We discussed buying or the children making bunny ears to wear whilst they were skipping. CG said she could ask Andrew at Tesco if they could provide some.

We would need to draw up a rota of time slots for children to skip (9:30-11:30 and 1:30 to 3) and then send out a parent mail asking for a certain amount of volunteers from parents of each class in the hope that more people will volunteer if its to help in their Childs class.
