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Year 1 Green Class News - Summer term 2024

Welcome back to the summer term! Hopefully lots of warmer weather will follow that will allow us to spend lots of time outside!

Reading

As usual, children's online books will be changed on a Friday afternoon after they have read the book 3 times in school. Please try to read through the book at least 3 times as well as share the library book together. We have noticed great progress in the children's fluency and expression when they practice their reading at home and we still can't stress enough how vital this is for their overall progression in school. Please contact us if you have any trouble logging into the books or for any other questions about reading.

Phonics

This term we will be completing the phonic screening assessment with each of the children individually. This is a statutory test designed to ensure children reach a certain level of phonics knowledge before they progress into year 2. We have been working very hard on our phonics and are very grateful to those of you who have been completing the phonics sheets sent on dojo. We may send home phonics catch up packs too if there are sounds that some children are struggling with, so look out for those.

Maths

The children have worked really hard on place value and are becoming more confident with addition and subtraction. We will be moving on to a simple form of fractions, time and money during this term which will build on their existing number knowledge. One of the best base skills children can have in maths is being able to recall key facts so any times you are able to practice these at home will benefit their understanding of number. These include number bonds to 10 (1+9, 2+8, 3+7 etc) and using these to work out number bonds to 20 (1+19, 2+18 etc). Also, any practice in counting in 2s, 10s and 5s would be really useful.
