Welcome back to our final term in year 4 where we will enjoy the residential, sports trips with QE as well as preparing for the transition to year 5.


Curriculum




Our first English unit, 'Monster Slayer', is a story based on the tale of Beowulf. Children will continue to improve their use of adverbial phrases, create characters and settings, and use the power of three. Later in the term, children will write their own myth. We will also look at non-fiction writing, including instructions and information texts. Our poetry this term will be based on animals.

Our maths will begin with understanding decimal numbers, then move onto money. Later in the term, we will learn to tell the time accurately and understand positional language. Throughout the term, we will continue to practice our multiplication facts in preparation for the Year 4 Multiplication Check. These tests will be taken during the week beginning 1st June 2026. It is essential you continue to support your child's learning of these at home.
