Hope you all had a fantastic Easter. Our learning this term is all about being outside and learning about the world around us.



Curriculum

In maths, Y2's will be applying their knowledge of adding, subtraction and place value when solving problems in measures. We shall begin to learn about fractions and also start to learn how to tell the time. Y1 will be tackling numbers to 100 and really getting to understand what the digits represent in 2 digit numbers.

We will be studying a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts in English and will be working hard on improving our use of punctuation and choice of words in our writing.

We shall continue to practice handwriting with Y1 children, making sure they are forming correctly and Y2 moving to joined up writing with some children ready to make the transition to fully joined.

Our 'World Around Me' Topic helps the children learn about different places in the world with a focus on Norway compared to Our location.

In Science we shall be learning about life cycles, both plants and minibeasts as well as growing some of our own vegetables.


Keeping active and healthy

Home Learning

Reading:

Our expectation is for the children to read at home every day. Reading for pleasure will help develop your child's vocabulary, communication, concentration, empathy and imagination. Children should be reading at home for at least 15 minutes every day. Within school, children will read in whole class reading sessions and group Little Wandle sessions. If your child is reading the Turquoise or Purple school books please make sure that they have them in school everyday as they will need them. Both Y1 and Y2 children have their spelling sheet to work on at home. Y2 are learning their 2,5, and 1-times tables. Y1 are securing their number bonds to 10

Getting Ready for Summer

Please make sure children have sun hats and sun cream for the warmer weather. It is useful to put cream on them before school so you make sure they have the correct cover. We can remind them to do a top up if it is really hot. Make sure they have a named hat too. Please make sure they have their water bottle, which we can refill at school if needed. Please make sure everything is labelled .
