Welcome back to the new school year!

We are very much looking forward to welcoming the class back and getting to know all of the children in the new Orange Class over the coming weeks!

Mr Wyatt will be teaching the class from Monday to Thursday and Miss Penny will teach on a Friday. We are very lucky to have support in class from Miss Poole every morning as well.

In year 4 we are aiming to become increasingly confident and independent across the year as we build on our key skills in reading, writing and maths.

Learning

Our main topic this term is geography based and will focus on comparing where we live in the South West to the Campania region in Italy.

In science, our topics are 'Living Things and their Habitats' and 'States of matter'.

Keeping Active & Healthy

PE is every Monday and Thursday. Please make sure your child has the correct kit in school each week and that it is clearly labelled. For the first half term we hope to do PE sessions on Monday afternoons with forest school sessions after half term (where waterproof coats and appropriate footwear will be essential). Thursdays PE session will be run by an Achieve4All coach.

Children can bring in a healthy morning snack (ideally fruit or vegetables) if they would like. Please ensure your child has their water bottle in school every day.

Home Learning

Reading

The expectation is for every child to read at home for at least 10 minutes as many times as possible, recording their reading in their record book. Within school the children will take part in whole class guided reading of texts/extracts with some children reading 1:1 with an adult regularly.

Times Tables

Learning times tables helps in so many areas of maths so please practise at home until fluent. Each child will already have access to Maths Shed through the Spelling Shed login where they can practise times tables. We will also be learning strategies within school.

Spelling

Spellings need to be part of the weekly routine for home learning. Each child will continue to have a login to Spelling Shed to practise spellings and revise patterns and rules. These rules will be taught in the lesson on Monday and recapped and practised throughout the week.

A maths based homework will be set by Mr Wyatt on a Thursday that will consolidate/practise learning from the week.

Keeping in touch

Class Dojo is great tool for staying in touch.

Please regularly check Class Dojo to be able to receive important information about what is happening in class.

A weekly update of learning will be posted each Thursday.
